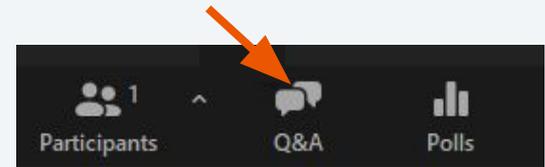

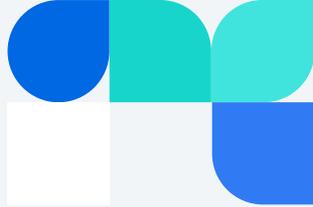

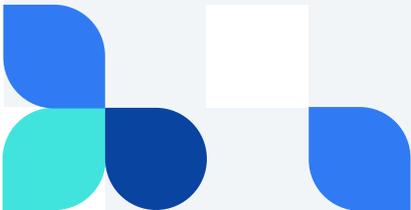

# Guardian Notifications: Lottery Email & Text Templates

## Settings > Content/Letters > Email and Text Templates

- Lottery Placement Accepted - Parent Notification
- Lottery Placement Declined - Parent Notification
- Lottery Results - Waiting List
- Lottery Results - Offered
- Lottery Placement Email Consolidated - Sent to All Students Placed

Assign these emails under:

**Schools/Programs > Manage Programs > Edit > Lottery Settings**

## Using Consolidated vs. Individual Placement Notifications

### **Consolidated:**

Sends one email notification to all students placed and what list they are in. Ideal for schools that want to keep notifications to a minimum

### **Individual:**

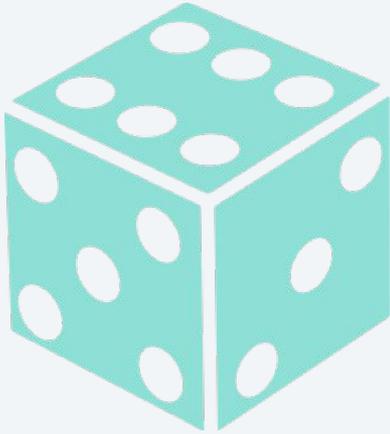
Sends an email for each placement that the student is in and where they are placed. Ideal for placement-specific verbiage

# Lottery Priorities



# Lottery: Priorities

Settings > Manage Lotteries > Lottery Priorities



Priorities are used to give students a **higher chance** to be placed on the offered list. Students with priorities are **more likely** to get into a school/program when the lottery is run, or will sit higher on the waitlist in comparison to students with no priorities if there is no space left on the offered list.

## Manual vs. Automatic Priorities

### Manual:

Applied manually by the admin to an application during the review process. This is usually done when there is more scrutiny required when awarding this priority.



### Automatic:

Automatically assigned for students who meet the corresponding criteria. Can be calculated by the system using student data tied to questions on the application



# Create a Priority

1. Go to Settings > Manage Lotteries > Lottery Priorities
2. Click on Add New Priority
3. Configure the settings outlined in the screenshot below

# Configure an Automatic Priority

The rules engine is used to create priority eligibility rules that automatically set these priorities as eligible for students who meet the specified criteria. If the student data matches the rule, then the student is eligible for the priority.

**Simple Lookup** allows you to choose the Field Name, Operator, and Expected value. For example, the priority above is going to be assigned to any student where the Zip Code is 70506



# Oprah's Favorite Lottery Priorities: Siblings

This is a common lottery priority used by many of our organizations

Use our Sibling Condition for Siblings Attending, and/or Siblings Applying. Sibling Applying is assigned as long as the students have a submitted application under the same guardian account. Sibling Attending is assigned through the Sibling step on the application form

# Oprah's Favorite Lottery Priorities: Address

This is another common lottery priority used by many of our organizations

Use our Student Address Condition if you have boundary files on your platform. You can prioritize students inside and/or outside of specific district, or school zones. No boundary files? No worries! As long as you are collecting address data, you can create one for State, City, or Zip!

# Oprah's Favorite Lottery Priorities: None!

Sometimes, you don't need a priority lottery. Here is what you can do:

You will want to ensure that the "priority" is something that can apply to ALL students. You can do this by creating a priority that applies to all applications that are marked as eligible. Students will then receive the "No Priority" priority on their eligible applications.

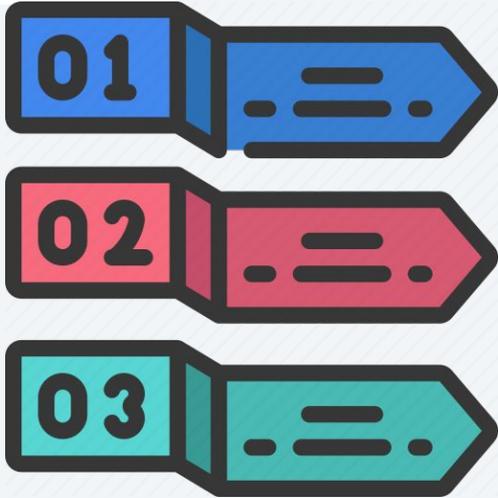

# Lottery: Designs

Settings > Manage Lotteries > Lottery Designs



While the priority is used to give the student's application a higher chance of placement, the sub-lottery that the priority is assigned to, along with the rules (entries, weights, quotas, etc.) in the lottery design, will drive where the student is actually placed on the lottery list. Many lotteries have one priority per sub-lottery. If you happen to have more than one priority in a sub-lottery, you can choose between a tiered or weighted design.



## I'll take Lottery Designs for 200, Alex!

### Tiered:

Assigns an **Entries** amount for each priority included in a **sub-lottery**. An application whose **highest priority has more entries** than other applications **in that same sub-lottery** will have an **increased chance** of being placed above the others. Entries **do not guarantee a higher placement**, they just increase the chances of higher placement **within a sub-lottery**.

### Weighted:

Assigns a **Weight** for each priority included in a **sub-lottery**. An application whose **highest priority has more weights** than other applications **in that same sub-lottery** will **always be placed above** other applications with a lower weight priority. Priority weight dictates the ordering of applications **within a sub-lottery**. Applications with **equal weight** priorities **within the same sub-lottery** will be **randomly ordered**.

### Score-Based:

Students are placed on the lottery list **according to the scores they receive**. This score and how it is calculated will vary based on the organization, but students can receive this score either through a formula created with a **calculated field type**, an **import**, or **manual scoring** documentation by admins. The admin can select the field where scores are collected the **sorting order** (either ascending or descending).

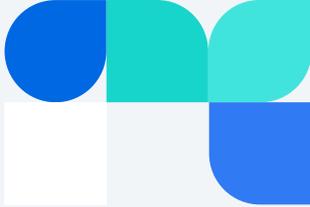

**Let's Look At Some Examples**

# Tiered Lottery

Think of entries as tickets in the (sub-lottery 1) metaphorical hat.

The Employee Child application has 4 more chances than the Board Member's 1 chance, but the Employee Child application is not guaranteed to get placed above the Board Member application

During the lottery execution, the randomization within the sub-lottery could pull the Board Member's 1 entry/ticket out of the hat before getting to any of the 4 entries/tickets for the Employee Child

# Weighted Lottery

Weights will typically be placed in a highest weight to lowest weight order

The application with the Employee Child priority with a weight of 4 will always be ordered above applications with the Sibling Attending or Board Member priorities with weights of 1.

Applications with either the Sibling Attending or the Board Member priority in this sub-lottery will be randomly ordered against each other, but always after applications with the Employee child priority.

# Scored Lottery

Score can be placed in Ascending vs Descending order

Application are being scored for auditions, and we want to place students with the highest score first, and students with the lowest score last

Applications with the same score can be set to be randomized amongst each other, or placed in order of date submitted when you go to run the lottery

# Seats or no seats...?

## Settings > Manage Lotteries > Lottery Cutoff Numbers

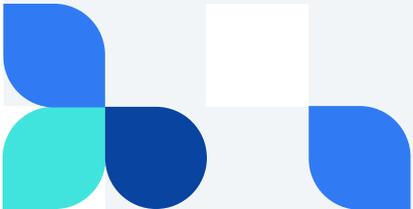

- Show lottery results on guardian dashboard

**Auto-Decline**

- Auto-decline a student's other applications on Offered Lists once a seat is accepted
- Auto-decline APPLICATIONS if OFFER is not accepted by:  
Days After Published Offer: 10 and/or Date\*: 01/31/2025 at Time of Day: 10:00 AM  
If the "Days After Published Offer" extends past the date in the "Date" field, then the auto-decline occurs on the earlier of the two dates.
- Auto-decline APPLICATIONS if REGISTRATION is not submitted by:  
Days After Accepting Seat: 10 and/or Date\*: 01/31/2025 at Time of Day: 05:00 PM  
If the "Days After Accepting Seat" extend past the date in the "Date" field, then the auto-decline occurs on the earlier of the two dates.

**These options affect auto-decline settings:**

- Send a reminder email/text message to warn guardians before auto-decline  
Days Before Auto-Decline\*: 1 at Time of Day: 10:00 AM
- Exclude weekends

**Waiting List**

- To-roll up applications from waiting list to offered list (when another application on offered list is declined)
- Roll over waiting lists when the school year is rolled over

**Post Lottery**

- Auto-add eligible applications to lottery list after initial lottery is run

**General**

- Place Multiples Together  
Same parent account & grade level required. Does not affect score-based lotteries.
- Same Address
- Twin Setting (same birthday ±1 day)

Review each setting carefully to align with your desired lottery settings!



Note: If you have auto-decline on execution, you will want to make sure to have auto-rollup on to fill your seats

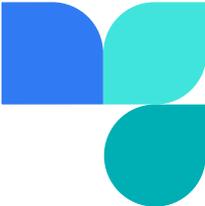

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# Q&A

**Q: Does the consolidated email get sent to students not in the lottery because they are marked ineligible?**

A: Correct. They wouldn't be automatically sent, but you can manually email those individuals in bulk to those students that have not been processed in the lottery. Only eligible lottery applicants who have gone through the lottery will be eligible to receive the notification once selected in your program lottery settings and published.

**Q: How do we know if the system is set for consolidated messages?**

A: This would be set up under your program lottery settings. You can find this by going to settings>schools & programs>manage programs>edit>lottery settings>Notifications> set notifications you would like to automatically go out there.  
If you would like to change consolidated email to separate, please reach out to Support on Zendesk or your CX

**Q: How do we add a link for a video to the email?**

A: You can do this in the settings>content/letters section and edit the template. You can add it in the body of the email - it will look like a square with a triangle in it. Something to note though is that the text template has a limited number of characters so a link might not fit in that instance.

**Q: I only have Tiered and Weighted Lottery as my options in Lottery Design. Seems like score-based would be better for our needs. How do I get this?**

A: A scored lottery is found in the sub-lottery itself, rather than the tabs at the top of the screen!
